



**SPECIFIC STUDENT MOBILITY AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
INSTITUTO TECNOLÓGICO DE SONORA (ITSON), MEXICO
AND
SATHYABAMA INSTITUTE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, INDIA**

Instituto Tecnológico de Sonora, located at Calle 5 de Febrero No. 818 Sur, Ciudad Obregon, Sonora Mexico, on the one hand, represented by Dr. Javier José Vales García, in his capacity as the Rector of the university, same that has all the legal faculties to celebrate this Agreement, as appears in the Power of Attorney, expressed in Public Deed No. 5,997, volume 80, dated April 05, 2016, in the presence of the Notary Lic. Horacio Alberto Olea Rodríguez, N° 31, in Ciudad Obregon, Municipality of Cajeme, Sonora, Mexico. On the other hand, Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology, a Deemed to be University, established under Sec.3 of the UGC Act, 1956, located at Rajiv Gandhi Road, Jeppiaar Nagar, Chennai-600 119, India and represented by Dr. S. Sundar Manoharan, Vice Chancellor agree to enter into this specific agreement on mobility of students of any academic level (associate, undergraduate and graduate degrees) subject to the following Clauses.

CLAUSES

FIRST. Each institution agrees to receive 4 students per year, same whom have reached the requirements that the Applicant University considers for this purpose.

SECOND. The host institution shall exempt from paying registration fees and tuition to students during their stay.

THIRD. The institution will provide the necessary assistance for housing and immigration procedures corresponding to the country. Remaining the responsibility for the student the expenses associated with these items, as well as transportation, health insurance, among others.

FOURTH. The institution shall receive 2 students per semester, with the exemption from payment of food, accommodation and tuition fees.

FIFTH. The student shall be enrolled at the host university and get the same rights and obligations that are set out in the relevant regulations, like any other student.

SIXTH. Each institution shall propose to the other candidates to participate in the program of academic, cultural and scientific exchanges. The host institution reserves the right to accept applicants based on their history and the budgetary possibilities and quota.

SEVENTH. The courses taken by the exchange student in the host institution shall be recognized and homologated according to regulations of the destination university.

EIGHTH. The grading scale in ITSON shall be: from 0 to 10, being 7 (seven) the minimum to pass the course.

NINETH. The grading scale in Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology shall be: from 0 to 10, being 5(five) the minimum to pass the course.

TENTH. The responsibility of this agreement shall be in charge of the Coordination of Academic Mobility and International Affairs by ITSON and Centre for Academic Partnership and International Relations by Sathyabama Institute of Science and Technology.
